



THE OVERSIGHT LAYER

Stop managing agents. Start running them.

One control center for every coding agent across every repository in your organization.

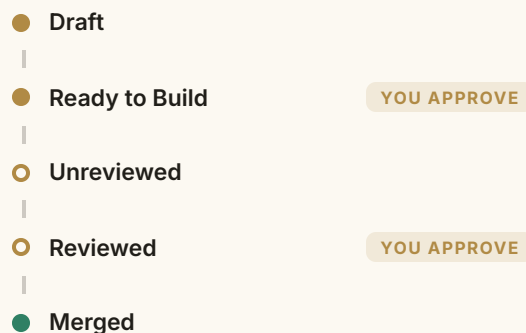
You've already got AI agents writing code. **The bottleneck isn't capability anymore — it's oversight.**

Every agent lives in its own terminal, its own repo, its own context. Which one is working right now? What did it decide? Is that PR still sitting unreviewed? You're not short on horsepower — you're short on visibility.

Agent God Mode gives you one screen for all of it. Create a Workstream and it moves through a pipeline you can see. Agents plan first. You approve. Then they build. Nothing ships without passing a gate you control.

Most teams hit a wall at their third agent, because oversight doesn't scale by opening more tabs. This is the layer that makes it scale.

Every repo, one view

Connect your whole GitHub org. Filter by repository, branch, status or agent without leaving the page.

Plans before code

Agents draft a plan and wait. You read it, accept it, and only then does anything get written.

Ten people, first round

Small on purpose. You get a private channel with the team and a direct line while you're testing.
